The year 2015 marks the 100th anniversary of the original subdivision of Nauset Heights.

WALKING TOUR OF VINTAGE COTTAGES

The conclusion to the 2015 Nauset Heights Centennial will be a Walking Tour of vintage cottages to be held on Saturday, September 12. Featuring nine early homes which still retain a vintage feel, and which are within easy walking distance of each other, the tour will be open free of charge to NHA members and their guests, as long as guests are accompanied by a member.

The tour will begin at the home of Robert and Rigney Cunningham at 85 Nauset Heights Road, where limited parking will be available. A gallery of old photos, early plot plans, charts, and maps will be on exhibit, as well as a DVD with original music

displaying a flyover of Nauset Heights and the outer beach. Members will receive a printed tour guide and proceed on foot to visit the cottages. Several vintage Jeeps will be available to ferry those in need of assistance up and down the hill on Nauset Road.

The owners of each house will be on hand to answer questions and talk about the history of their homes. A reception with light refreshments will be held at the last stop on the tour. A fitting end to our 2015 Centennial celebration!
