Ann presented a review of all the summer 2022 events. The Fall Cleanup is still to come on October 15. She thanked the Lawn Party committee for another successful event. She called attention to the Enterprise Table, which was stocked with NHA wine glasses, aprons, caps, aerial photos, and the last copies of the Nauset Heights History book.

Ann thanked three retiring officers: King Nelson, Richard Thompson, and Pat Tyng, and retiring member of the Board of Directors, Duke Duquette.

Ann introduced Dave Strickler who presented the slate of nominees for next year. They are: President - Mark Ayer 1st Vice President – Scott Zenke Treasurer - Dave Strickler Corresponding Secretary – Kathy Pattison Recording Secretary – Nancy Case (There is no nominee for 2nd Vice President at this time)

New members of the Board of Directors will be Paul Soules, Elyse Klein, Laura Ogonowski, and Josh Payne. The slate of nominees was approved.

Ann turned the meeting over to new President Mark Ayer, who thanked her for two successful years as President. Mark mentioned that the wine tasting, a new event in 2022, received good attendance, and he hopes to have two such events next season.
